Paper Packaging

Introduction We at REWE Group are committed to take on ambitious goals to protect our environment. Given that a large part of our packaging consists of paper, we have pledged to tackle paper packaging of our private label products as part of our overall packaging strategy. Subsequently, we aim to promote responsible forestry and biodiversity by using certified recycled paper and certified fresh fiber paper in order to conserve resources wherever we cannot avoid or reduce our existing packaging.

Goal The goal is to make all primary paper packaging mentioned in the scope of this one pager more eco-friendly by using certified recycled paper or certified fresh fiber.

Scope

- Own and exclusive labels for assortment & promotion articles (REWE, PENNY and toom Baumarkt)
- Primary packaging (sales/product packaging) that consist of more than 30% paper. Primary packaging also includes inserts or inlays, wrapping paper, corner protection, header cards, but no user manuals
- Certification of sleeves, labels or similar, that makes less than 30% of packaging, is desirable

Detailed Information

- Our direct suppliers (food/product manufacturers) and REWE Group do not need to be certified.
- However, our direct suppliers have to ensure that the last entity processing / modifying the primary packaging (e.g. the printing house or the manufacturer of the product) is FSC or PEFC certified (Proof through the FSC-license-number: FSC-C-xxxxxx or the PEFC license number: xx-xx-xxxx).
- The FSC or PEFC logo on the primary packaging (no logo on inlays or inserts) includes the FSC or PEFC license number of the invoice to REWE or the manufacturer of the product or the printing house (but not the packaging manufacturer). The logo has to comply with the FSC or PEFC logo guidelines.

Cost The cost for certification is borne by the supplier / production site.
